The Building

- **710,000 square feet**
- **11 Stories**
- **360 feet long, east to west**
- **Private patient rooms with intensive care capability**
 - 450 patient rooms System wide
 - All rooms equipped for double occupancy in case of emergency
- **Green space will make up nearly half of our campus**



The Building

- **Patient rooms feature floor-to-ceiling windows with high level of privacy, technology, comfort and safety**
- **New hospital will connect to Critical Care Pavilion**
 - The Critical Care Pavilion will be converted to house women & children's care
 - Includes labor & delivery and the neonatal intensive care unit (NICU)
 - Dedicated entrance
- **Separate elevators for patients and staff/services**



The Building

- **Main entrance on Scranton Road**
- **Two-story lobby will feature:**
 - Gift shop
 - Dining terrace
 - Open views to outdoor green space
 - Space for arts performances (choir, piano, dance, etc.)
