Cardiac: Heart Lab with Dissection

Our cardiac dissection lab is a dynamic lab utilizing a hybrid of lecture, hands-on and dissection to facilitate continuing education. Our Metro Life Flight crews foster these courses at our regional fire/EMS departments by utilizing a pig heart due to its close resemblance to that of a human. The course consists of: anatomy & physiology of the heart, pathology of cardiac disease, cardiothoracic trauma, assessment and treatment of the cardiac patient.



Cost: \$1,000 for up to 30 participants who each receive their own heart specimen dissection kits.

Neurological: Brain Lab with Dissection



Our neurological lab with dissection is a dynamic lab utilizing a hybrid of lecture, hands on and dissection to facilitate continuing education. Our Metro Life Flight teams foster these courses at our regional fire/EMS departments by utilizing a sheep brain due to its close resemblance to that of a human. The course consists of anatomy & physiology of the brain, pathology of neurological disease, stroke, brain and spinal cord trauma, common neurological ailments and the assessment and treatment of the neurologically injured patient.

Cost: \$1,000 for up to 30 participants who each receive their own brain specimen dissection kits.

A Comprehensive Review & Fetal Pig Dissection

Our most comprehensive course with dissection is a dynamic lab utilizing a hybrid of lecture, hands on and dissection to facilitate continuing education. Our Metro Life Flight teams foster these courses at our regional fire/EMS departments by utilizing a fetal pig due to its close resemblance to that of a human. The course consists of anatomy & physiology, pathology of disease, trauma, common medical ailments and assessment and treatment modalities of common chief complaints.



Cost: \$1,200 for up to 30 participants who each receive their own fetal pig dissection kits.

For each lab, all equipment, supplies and instruction is provided by Metro Life Flight and MetroHealth experts. The course will last approximately 2 hours. Each participant will receive 2 hours of EMS Continuing Education.
