

What is MetroHealth N.E.T.?

MetroHealth N.E.T. stands for Now, Every day, Tomorrow (N.E.T.). As an affiliated committee of The MetroHealth Foundation, this group of young, professional, civically-minded leaders is committed to advancing The MetroHealth System's mission, expanding the network of members, and creating a culture of philanthropic support.

N.E.T.'s mission is to leverage the resources of the emerging professionals community to promote and sustain MetroHealth initiatives that create a healthier Northeast Ohio community, and to support the MetroHealth Transformation.

What does MetroHealth N.E.T. do?

The MetroHealth N.E.T. committee supports outreach and organizes and hosts several events each year to raise important funds – and awareness –that sustain the work of MetroHealth.

Activities include:

- Raising the NETs Volleyball Tournament. Annual volleyball tournament planned and hosted by N.E.T. members. The event draws nearly 200 participants and proceeds support the MetroHealth Transformation.
- *Turnout for Transformation*. Promotion of corporate fundraising toolkit called Turnout for Transformation designed for organizations to host fundraisers to benefit MetroHealth.
- Young Professional Group Outreach and Presentations. Conduct outreach and present to corporate and community YP groups to share information on the MetroHealth Transformation.
- MetroHealth Event Promotion. Generate interest, excitement and participation in MetroHealth events among friends, family and co-workers by sharing event information on social media, in corporate communications and through other networks.
- Team Building and Fundraising. Attend and support several smaller social and networking events held each year to team-build (and fundraise) among N.E.T. Committee members, MetroHealth staff, members of the MetroHealth Foundation Board and the community.
