This online education aims to support nurses in all settings to improve screening, interventions and care coordination services to those in need of specialized addiction treatment.

These self-directed and flexible courses, developed in conjunction with healthcare professionals from our Opioid Consortium membership, have a 90% satisfaction rating and over 88% of participants surveyed said they feel more prepared to care for SUD/OUD patients after taking the courses.
