About MyMedicare.gov

MyMedicare.gov gives you access to your personalized information at any time.

- ▶ Create a list of favorite health care providers and indicate your “primary clinician.”
- ▶ Check your Medicare claims as soon as they’re processed.
- ▶ Find your eligibility, entitlement, and preventive service information.
- ▶ Check your health and prescription drug enrollment information.
- ▶ View your Part B deductible information.
- ▶ Manage your prescription drug list and other personal health information.
- ▶ Create a printable “On the Go” Report that you can share with your health care providers.

Create a MyMedicare.gov Account

- 1 Visit MyMedicare.gov and click the **Create an Account** button in the Secure Sign In box.
- 2 Complete all form fields and click **Continue**. You’re all registered.
- 3 Registration is complete.

Select Your Primary Clinician on MyMedicare.gov

Once you’re registered on MyMedicare.gov, you can select your primary clinician. Your primary clinician may be best able to help you make health care decisions, which can improve how you manage your health care and lead to better results. By choosing a primary clinician, your doctor may have access to more tools or services for your care available to patients of doctors participating in an Accountable Care Organization or other Medicare alternative payment models. Accountable Care Organizations are groups of doctors, hospitals, and other health care providers, who come together voluntarily to give coordinated high quality care to their Medicare patients.

How to Select Your Primary Clinician

- 1 Log in to your MyMedicare.gov account.
- 2 Search for your primary clinician by typing their name into the provider search tool.
- 3 Select the **Add as my primary clinician** option under the provider’s name.

Things to Think About When Choosing a Primary Clinician

- ✓ A primary clinician is the practitioner that you want responsible for coordinating your overall care.
- ✓ Your primary clinician is responsible for coordinating your care, regardless of where you choose to get services.
- ✓ Selecting a primary clinician is completely optional. It won’t affect your care or choice of physician. You can still go to any doctor who accepts Medicare.
- ✓ You can change your primary clinician after selection, and select another physician as your primary clinician. Your selection of a primary clinician will remain the same unless you decide to change your designation.
