## 2019 - 2020 Clinic Schedule



The clinics are open to all students, with a signed consent form, from the school. There is no cost to families or students to come to a MetroHealth School Health Program Clinic. In fact, you don't have to be a current MetroHealth patient.

### Services Offered by Clinic

- Sports/school/camp physicals
- Immunizations/shots
- Urgent care visits
- Care for common health concerns
- Well child visits
- Teen health issues
- Mental and behavioral health screenings and referral to in-school services
- Basic lab testing

### How to Use Our Program:

#### 1. Register/Consent

- Complete Patient Registration Form
- Sign the Consent Form 2 times, front and back

#### 2. Return Forms

- Return both signed forms to school nurse

#### 3. Payment

- NO cost to families
- Insurance will be billed, when able
- NO copays

#### 4. Schedule Appointment

- Contact school nurse to schedule an appointment for child to be seen

#### 5. Clinic Visit

- Parents can come, but don't have to be present for clinic visit
- Parent can be called on the phone during visit
- After Visit Summary sent home
