Services Offered by Clinic

- Sports/school/camp physicals
- Immunizations/shots
- Urgent care visits
- Care for common health concerns
- Well child visits
- Teen health issues
- Mental and behavioral health screenings and referral to in-school services
- Basic lab testing

How to Use Our Program:

- 1. Register/Consent
 - Complete Patient Registration Form
 - Sign the Consent Form 2 times, front and back
- 2. Return Forms
 - Return both signed forms to school nurse

3. Payment

- NO cost to families
- Insurance will be billed, when able
- NO copays

4. Schedule Appointment

Contact school nurse to schedule an appointment for child to be seen

5. Clinic Visit

- Parents can come, but don't have to be present for clinic visit
- Parent can be called on the phone during visit
