

Facilitation Guide

1. Conduct the briefing and prepare your learners
2. Provide a clear start to the simulation
3. Consider your location
4. Use confederates to maintain realism and ensure flow
5. Let the interaction flow naturally
6. Take notes according to the objectives and critical actions
7. Keep an eye on the time
8. Say "simulation over" at the appropriate time
9. Listen to learners as you move to debriefing
