POPULATION HEALTH AND EQUITY RESEARCH INSTITUTE (PHERI) 2023 ANNUAL REPORT EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In 2023, The MetroHealth Population Health and Equity Research Institute (PHERI) entered the third year of implementing our 2020 strategic plan to meet our shared mission of leading the way to a healthy, thriving, equitable community and nation through actionable research, education and collaboration. We added equity into our Institute name to raise the visibility on the strong equity-focused work of all 3 Centers within PHERI. In 2023, PHERI faculty held 38 active grants where our ~17 core faculty serve as PI, co-PI or site PI totaling over 31 million dollars (increased from 27 grants and 17 million dollars in 2020) with 7 new grants in 2023 (see 2023 PHERI Grants Table). PHERI faculty also serve as co-Is on 29 collaborative grants bringing in an additional 24 million dollars.

Several key newly funded grants in 2023 include:

- 1. 5-year \$1.29 million NIA grant entitled "Digital Twin Neighborhoods for Research on Place-Based Health Inequalities in Mid-Life" (Pls Perzynski, Dalton). This project aims to chart a new course for understanding place-based population health strategies, and to use evidence from place-based research to inform, prioritize, evaluate and implement health-promoting strategies that close health disparities.
- 2. 5-year \$3.75 million CDC grant (**PIs Caron, Bolen** in collaboration with CWRU, UH, CCF, Centers FQHC, along with community and payer partners) entitled "Heart Health Equity in Cuyahoga County Communities" to improve hypertension and cholesterol equity by addressing social drivers of health and enhancing access to clinical care in neighborhoods with the highest cardiovascular risk.
- 3. 5-year \$540,000 R25 Research Education Grant from NIH (**PIs Thornton and Hickman**) to increase the diversity of the scientific workforce, entitled "An Intensive Summer Education Program in Translational Research for Underrepresented Students (INSPIRE-US)".
- 4. 5-year NIA grant entitled "Increasing the Feasibility, Impact, and Equity of the Medicare Annual Wellness Visit" (Site PI Kaelber)
- 5. 7-year renewal of the Clinical and Translational Science Collaborative focused on advancing health equity research (CWRU PI McComsey, MetroHealth Site PI Singer, Informatics Module Co-Lead **Kaelber**, Biostats and Epidemiology Research Design Site Lead **Gunzler**, and Community and Stakeholder Engagement Module Co-Lead **Bolen**).
- 6. AHRQ Conference grant which supported a national Summit on the Advancement of Focused Equity Research in Trauma (SAFER-Trauma) led by **Dr. Ho** as Pl.

Beyond funded grants and projects, we continued to grow faculty and build collaborations in 2023 to assist in meeting our mission, with over 45 collaborating faculty. We continued our monthly community-based research network meetings and maintained relationships with

our <u>over 40 community partners</u>. We held a <u>Community Research Dissemination Day</u> on the theme of "Community-Academic Research Partnership Successes, Challenges and Impact in the Communities We Serve" with 55 attendees in April 2023 at the Greater Cleveland Food Bank.

We hired 1 new family medicine investigator (Dr. Patil) focused on addressing health equity in chronic disease management, and incorporated MetroHealth surgeon Dr. Vanessa Ho as core faculty within our Center for Health Equity Engagement Education and Research (CHEEER) to further support her research focused on eliminating disparities in people experiencing general surgery and trauma. We also continued our 2nd year of the PHERI research fellowship, supporting and training our 2 excellent research fellows focused on gun violence survivorship, addressing social drivers of health, and pediatric child development.

PHERI faculty continued to disseminate their work to enhance the regional and national reputation of The MetroHealth System and Case Western Reserve University (CWRU). We continued to increase our <u>publications to 129 in 2023</u> (from 38 in 2019, 58 in 2020, and 90 in 2022) around key topic areas such as health disparities, social drivers of health, cardiovascular health, and health informatics (see **2023 PHERI Publication List**).

- In a collaboration with I4HOPE, we published in the New England Journal of Medicine Catalyst Innovations in Care Delivery in March 2023 on "<u>Understanding</u> and Addressing Social Drivers of Health: <u>Insights from the MetroHealth Institute for</u> <u>HOPETM</u>." Fuehrer S, Misak JE, Chagin K, Cook K, Jackson L, Santiago M, Simpson M, **Sehgal AR**.
- 3. **Dr. Tarabichi** and members of the CCIRE team (**Kaelber**, **Riley**) were published in the Journal of General Internal Medicine for a study using Artificial Intelligence (AI) to predict the probability of no-show appointments in a busy clinic followed up with personal outreach to those patients which resulted in improved show rates for Black at-risk patients. <u>Publication can be found here</u>.
- 4. An article in the American Journal of Public Health highlighting improved glycemic control across Ohio entitled "A Medicaid-Funded Statewide Diabetes Quality Improvement Collaborative: Ohio 2020–2022." Bolen SD, Joseph JJ, Dungan KM, Beverly EA, Perzynski AT, Einstadter D, Fiegl J, Love TE, Spence D, Jenkins K, Lorenz A, Uddin SJ, Adams KM, Konstan MW, Applegate MS.
- 5. **Dr. Gaglioti** and colleagues published a <u>study</u> in the Journal of the American Board of Family Medicine demonstrating that greater continuity of care with the same primary care provider was associated with fewer hospitalizations and emergency room visits among Medicaid enrollees with chronic conditions.

- 6. An article with learnings around teen suicide in high-risk populations by **Dr. De Luca** and colleagues, entitled "<u>Is anybody there? A longitudinal examination of helpseeking and suicidal risk among Latino, Black, and non-Hispanic white adolescents." Suicide Life Threat Behav. 2023 Jun;53(3):385-398.</u>
- 7. An <u>AHA and AMA Scientific Statement</u> entitled "Implementation Strategies to Improve Blood Pressure Control in the US" where **Dr. Bolen** is a co-author.

Our faculty were <u>invited to provide ~20 national presentations in 2023</u> (see **2023 PHERI Invited National Presentations**), with more than 100 other regional and national presentations in 2023 highlighting PHERI activities (see **2023 PHERI Abstracts/Conference Talks List**). We also continued our PHERI Annual Visiting Professor Series around population health and our Annual Duncan Neuhauser Lecture Series around quality improvement.

Our PHERI faculty mentored over 80 trainees in 2023 (up from 65 in the last few years) on population health and equity focused research including around 20 residents and faculty from The MetroHealth System and over 35 CWRU students (see 2023 PHERI Trainees Table). In addition to mentoring trainees, we continued to teach high profile courses at CWRU, including but not limited to the following: 1) Design and Analysis of Observational Studies led by Dr. Love, PHERI Director of Biostatistics and Data Sciences; 2) Introduction to Clinical Research Scholars Program led by Dr. Einstadter; 3) Qualitative and Mixed Methods in Public Health led by Dr. Perzynski; and 4) Computing in Biomedical and Health Informatics led by Dr. Kaelber. We continue to assist in teaching Block 1 and 3 CWRU medical students. Our PHERI faculty have had several awards, honors and promotions in the past year based on their work including community partnership and mentorship awards as well as top ranked national abstracts (see 2023 PHERI Honors, Awards, and Promotions List). Lastly, PHERI faculty have filled over 100 critical service roles nationally and regionally, including service roles within MetroHealth, within CWRU, and within the community (see PHERI Service Roles List 2023). We look forward to future activities in 2024.
