#### **Background**

CCH Development Corporation owns several parcels of property on West 25th and West 30th Streets for development that surround and/or are adjacent to the Property.

Prior to MetroHealth's acquisition of the Property, the Property was operated as a gas station. The underground gas tanks at the Property were removed before MetroHealth acquired it, but the soil at the Property requires remediation before the Property can be developed.

CCH Development Corporation obtained a brownfield remediation grant from the State of Ohio, the proceeds of which it intends to use to remediate the soil at the Property.

Pursuant to Resolution 19115, the Board approved the formation of CCH Development Corporation for the purpose of providing options in connection with the acquisition, development, and use of real estate for the purpose of better providing for the health and welfare of the community.

MetroHealth has determined that the transfer of the Property to CCH Development Corporation will support and further the mission of MetroHealth and will promote the health, safety, and welfare of, and be in the best interests of, the community that MetroHealth serves. CCH Development Corporation intends to use the Property in furtherance of its corporate purposes, including real estate-oriented activities, which may include housing and/or other types of community development that support and further the mission of MetroHealth and better provide for the health, safety, and welfare of the community MetroHealth serves.
