Susan provided details on efforts including patient screening, programs to address food insecurity, transportation, housing, economic stability, education, school health, infant mortality and digital access. B. Update on Faith-Based Initiatives

Tony Minor, Manager of Faith Community Outreach, provided an update on faith-based engagement and initiatives. Accomplishments discussed included: Establishing Pathways to Health and Healing as a model to engage congregations, recruiting 40 congregations to participate in Safe Sleep Sunday, completing a plan for Jewish faith leaders and identified co-chairs for interfaith council, increased trauma competency of local congregations and established two Healing Circles.
