



Cleveland State University School of Nursing Offers a Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) Degree at The MetroHealth System Main Campus

Are you interested in returning to school for your MSN, but unsure about the online learning environment? This program uses a blended delivery approach (face-to-face and online delivery of course work)

Cleveland State University (CSU) School of Nursing is partnering with MetroHealth to offer a MSN Degree at MetroHealth Main Campus. All courses will be taught by CSU School of Nursing Professors.

The <u>Fourth</u> cohort will begin May 2020, with classes taking place Wednesdays, 4:30pm-7:30pm at MetroHealth Main Campus.

Highlights of the CSU School of Nursing MSN Degree program include:

- Complete your degree in two years by taking two courses per semester
- Receive up to \$6,000 per calendar year with MetroHealth's Tuition Assistance Program
- Choose from four specialization tracks including Nursing Education, Clinical Nurse Leader, Specialized Populations in Nursing, and Forensic Nursing
- Courses taught by CSU School of Nursing professors
- The master's degree in nursing program at Cleveland State University is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education, One Dupont Circle, NW, Suite 530, Washington, DC 20036, 202-887-6791.
- All courses are Quality Matters[™] approved and meet national standards for excellence in online course design
- CSU has a Budget Payment Plan option that will allow for 25% to be paid upfront each semester with the balance being paid up to 21 days after the term is over giving employees time to receive their tuition assistance.
